


# Custom Content Builder: Adding Disclaimers (including ACA 1557)

For all customers, that license Custom Content Builder (CCB), there is a feature that allows clients to add user-defined notes or disclaimers on the bottom of every HealthSheet™. This feature was created, in part, for customers that need to add disclaimers to support their Affordable Care Act (ACA) 1557 requirements but can be used for other purposes as well. For more information on ACA 1557, please refer to the Federal Register and go to the Accountable Care Act, Section 1557.

To utilize this feature, you must have Account Manager access in Ignite On-Demand. Then, when you access the Custom Content tab, you will see a new option available that says, “Configure Disclaimers (e.g., ACA 1557)”. See screen below:

Once you have selected this option, a new screen will appear, Define Disclaimers (e.g., ACA 1557). This is where you will be able to enter and define the disclaimers you want to print on the bottom of every HealthSheet. In the box, enter the disclaimers with the proper spacing you desire. Then, you will need to check to box, “Show disclaimers at the bottom of HealthSheets (e.g., ACA 1557)”, to indicate the disclaimer is to be printed on every HealthSheet. See sample screen below:

Once you print a HealthSheet, this new disclaimer will appear at the bottom of the HealthSheet, but prior to the footnotes. See example below:

### How Acid Reflux Affects Your Throat

Do you have to clear your throat or cough often? Are you hoarse? Do you have trouble swallowing or heartburn or pain in your throat? If you have these or other throat symptoms, you may have acid reflux. This occurs when stomach acid flows back up and irritates your throat.

**Why you have throat symptoms**

There are muscles (esophageal sphincters) at both ends of the tube that carries food to your stomach (the esophagus). These muscles relax to let food pass. Then they tighten to keep stomach acid down. When the lower esophageal sphincter (LES) doesn't tighten enough, acid can flow back (reflux) from your stomach into your esophagus. This may cause heartburn. In some cases the upper esophageal sphincter (UES) also doesn't work well. Then acid can travel higher and enter your throat (pharynx). In many cases, this causes throat symptoms.

**Common throat symptoms**

- Need to clear your throat often
- Feeling like you're choking
- Long-term (chronic) cough
- Hoarseness
- Trouble swallowing
- Feel like you have a lump in your throat
- Sour or acid taste
- Sore throat that keeps coming back

Customer-defined disclaimer information, such as ACA 1557, can be added to the bottom of every HealthSheet. This includes both Ignite HealthSheets, Exit-Writer® Discharge Instructions, Video HealthSheets, KidsHealth® Instructions, as well as custom documents created by the customer.

**Note:** This feature can accommodate very long, and multiple-line disclaimers. Therefore, the printing of the HealthSheet will often flow over to multiple pages. Additionally, if you are using the Content Exporter module, disclaimers do not get applied to exported documents.
